Dear Parent/Guardian:

Please note the following information about Oradell Public School's Halloween celebration.

- OPS will have one lunch period on Monday, October 31, 2011 from 11:30 a.m. until 12:45 p.m. Kindly return the form sent home last week to your child's teacher by Wednesday, October 26, 2011 indicating your child's lunch plans.
- Our student Halloween parade will be held on Memorial Field at 1:15 p.m. fair weather only. In the event of rain or other inclement weather we will not hold a Halloween parade. Our students will enjoy classroom Halloween celebrations.
- Please note that all visitors to the school on Halloween, or any other day, must enter the school through the Main Entrance and sign in at the Main Office. Only visitors who have a pre-approved reason for visitation will be admitted. In addition, all visitors must be recognizable (i.e. no masks or make-up which will prevent easy identification), and present proper identification if requested.
- As in the past, I request that you not dress your children in costumes which are gruesome or gory. Such costumes are unnerving to our younger students. Children should also refrain from carrying toy guns, toy weapons, etc. . .
