The Oradell teachers have decided to exercise their right on October 10 not to work on a holiday (N.J.S.A. 18A:25-3). As a result, OPS will be closed on Monday, October 10th for the entire day for teachers and students. The single session day originally planned for that day has been moved to Tuesday, October 11, 2011, thus allowing for required HIB training to take place for all staff in the afternoon.

Please note the following important school calendar changes for the month of October.

- **Monday, October 10, 2011, school will be closed for the entire day for students and teachers. This day was originally scheduled to be a 12:30 p.m. dismissal day.**
- **Tuesday, October 11, 2011, is now a 12:30 p.m. early dismissal day. This day was originally scheduled to be a full day of school.**

In addition, it was felt that it was essential that the district maintain the four snow days that were planned in the previous calendar. In order to do this, the calendar reflects a revision of **April, 2012** as follows.

April 6, 2012	Good Friday	Schools Closed
April 9-12, 2012	Spring Recess	Schools Closed
April 13, 2012	Regular School Day for students and staff
