Label photos on the back with your name, the name of the event, **AND THE NAMES OF ALL CHILDREN PICTURED.** (It's best to use a label or a permanent fine line marker that will not rub off on other photos.) Photos should be no larger than 4"x6". Please note: all photos must be of OPS events and all children pictured must be OPS students.

Put your photos in an envelope marked "**Memory Book Photos**" and bring them to the OK Foundation mailbox in the OPS main office (not the PTA mailbox). Photos submitted to the Memory Book will not be returned to you.

All "first day," Halloween, and Sharpe Trip photos must be received no later than Monday, January 16th. (Photos of these events submitted after the deadline will not be included in the Memory Book and will not be returned.) Photos for all other events will be accepted at any time as the events occur. Please submit all photos as soon after the events as possible.
