The Oradell PTA sponsors many great programs that foster academic excellence, including:

- **Grade Level Grants:** Allows faculty in each grade to host programs that enhance the educational experience. This includes visits from Liberty Science Center, High Touch High Tech of NJ, and more.
- **Student Programming:** Last year we brought the hugely popular Raptor project – the largest collection of travelling birds of prey in the world. This year, Bubblemania (the science of bubbles) is coming to OPS in October!
- **Community Health and Safety:** Last year the PTA provided pedometers to every child in the school. This year we're looking to make Walk to School Day not an event... but the norm.
- **After School Book Clubs:** Offered three times a year for grades K-3. Check [www.oradellpta.org](http://www.oradellpta.org) for a schedule of the first meetings this fall. Our very successful upper grades book club will once again take place during lunch period for any interested students in grades 4-6.
- **Reading is Fundamental:** Provides two free books each year for every OPS student.
- **Science Fair:** Children in grades K-6 can participate in our spring fair. Also, look for special after school science workshops throughout the year and our annual Science Day.
- **Reflections Arts Program:** Encourages students in the areas of choreography, visual arts, writing, musical composition and more.
- **Community Outreach:** Coordinates service projects to help those in need, including coat drives, food drives and much more.

The PTA also provides several key services to the school including: class photo day, the student directory, the PTA "OPTAmist" newsletter, beautification of the grounds, activities during the long winter months of indoor lunch and babysitting training for our sixth graders.

PTA programs would not be possible without our fundraisers – lunches, Box Tops, Spirit Wear, Thanksgiving pie sale, In-Store Promotions and so much more. This year we are offering twice as many lunches as in years past. We are also adding a new Holiday Boutique for the children in December.
