




Percent Passing Sub-Group Performance in 3rd Grade




Percent Passing Sub-Group Performance in 4th Grade







School Ranking - Cohort Performance in Math by School


Comparing School Ranking (Same Students) Over Time

- Reached out to River Edge regarding any interventions they may be using that are reaping rewards.

- Form B Navigator Data Meetings to identify:
 - Areas that need improvement
 - Students who are showing lower levels of growth
- Implementation for targeted intervention during after-school hours for students scoring "approaching expectations," i.e. the students that are identified by Linkit! as "Bubble Students."
- Continued professional development on meeting the needs of all academic learners.
