# 2019 - 2020: MOVING FORWARD TOGETHER!

**District Goal 1: Increase the number of students who move up from Approaching or Below to either Meeting or Exceeding in Math (80%) and English Language Arts (90%):**

- Continued focus on using data to inform instruction -- teaching the student not just the curriculum.
  - Using Linkit!, chapter assessments and ongoing daily assessments to identify strengths and areas to strengthen.
  - Focusing on the structure of the WIN period as a way to meet individual needs.
  - Continued parent academies and communication with parents regarding supporting students at home.
  - Review of additional District resources and leveraging them to meet student needs.
- Continued professional development in a Guided Math Workshop and a Balanced Literacy approach to instruction.
- Increased focus on articulation across grade levels to ensure consistency of teaching practice.
