

**Bylaw**

---

ELECTION AND DUTIES OF THE VICE PRESIDENT

The vice president of the Oradell Board of Education shall:

- A. Perform all duties of the president in his/her absence; and
- B. Perform such other duties as may be designated to him/her.

When the office of president is vacant, the vice president shall serve as acting president until a new president is seated.
